It has been great to see a number of Key Worker pupils return to school this morning. Could I remind you that you will need to provide evidence from your employee that you are a Key Worker. If you wish your child to receive a school meal could you let the office know.

I would like to take this opportunity to update you on the situation regarding Remote Learning. The staff have been working incredibly hard to ensure that we are able to start moving to Remote Learning from tomorrow.

We have been updating our Remote Education Provision information for you to take note of and read. This will inform you about the school's approach to home learning over the next few weeks. We realise that alterations will need to be made as we become more familiar with use of Remote Learning.

You will be receiving instructions to inform you how to log on to your child's Office 365 account for use of the Teams app. We hope that all pupils will be able to access their accounts and begin to speak to their class teachers in the next few days. We realise that not all pupils will have access to the internet or have devices at home. Please remember, if you would prefer a paper copy, could I ask you to contact your class teacher and these will be made available for collection from the reception area at school.

Please could I remind you that you should not send your child to school if you or anyone in your household is displaying symptoms of coronavirus. If this is the case, please inform school immediately.
