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Class 1 News

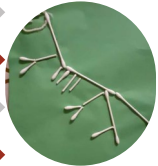


Dinosaurs have landed!

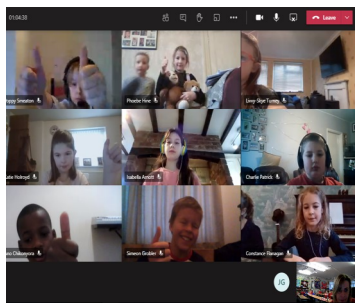
In maths Year 2 have been practising their x2 x5 and 10x tables. They have also been doubling. Year 1 have been practising their number bonds and addition.
