All of Class 2, both at home and at school, have had a wonderful return to school this week.

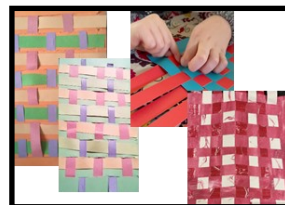
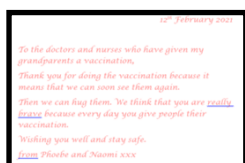
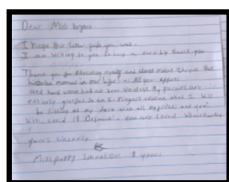
They have been working hard in all their subjects. In English, we have started a new story - The Magic Paintbrush. The children have created their own story plans and have been able to talk about the mood of the story.
