Headteacher Awards for this week:

All pupils have been given a **Headteacher award** this week for their good behaviour and attitude to learning. We were very proud of them all during our **Ofsted** visit.

Ofsted — As you will know we were informed by **Ofsted** on Wednesday of this week that they were inspecting the school on Thursday. There were two visitors from **Ofsted**, **HMI** and we feel that the inspection went well. We have got to wait about three weeks to receive the detailed report and will inform you as soon as we can of the result.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank **all the members of staff** for their commitment, hard work and dedication to the school, especially this week! I would also like to thank all the **Governors and volunteers** who help so much to make this school what it is.

Library Van — Pupils from **Class 3** and **4** have visited the mobile library van when it is in the village on a Friday morning over the last few years. Recently the timetable has changed and the van is now here after school time. The children have really benefitted from these visits and enjoyed reading the books and writing about their stories. **We are very disappointed that the pupils will no longer be able to visit the library** as part of their learning and have contacted the Council and Parish Council to try to get this changed. **We are also concerned that if the library van is not supported by the school the service may get stopped.** If you are also concerned about the change please contact the Council; the more people who raise this issue the more chance we have got of getting it changed.

After School Clubs — **Drama Club** is starting on Thursday after school and we have got a great overview of what will happen each week for the 10 weeks until the end of term, this is available to review in the school office. There are a few places still available please contact the school office if you would like a form. **Well Being Club** will be held on Tuesday 14th May this half term and then on every Tuesday of the following half term, new starters to the club are very welcome. **Forest Schools Club** will be replaced with **multi-sports** for the next few Wednesdays. All clubs are for an hour until 4.30 and cost £5 per session which is charged as **Out of School Club** payable on **ParentPay**.
