Homework Information:

We recommend 10 minutes for Reading or telling the story and practising sounds (when they have a sound) every night throughout Reception and 15 minutes, every night.

PE and Games Kit. Please ensure your child has:

PE - red polo shirt, Black Shorts, Black Pumps to wear on PE days.

Games - as above plus a sweatshirt and tracksuit/ jogging trousers, trainers.

Jewellery must not be worn for any PE or Sports activities. Earrings must be taped or removed by the wearer.

Busy Bee Time: This is what is called continuous provision. This occurs inside and outside and as such please send in appropriate outdoor clothes and shoes for your child to use in all weathers. Our timetable is flexible enough to support your child getting in and out of outdoor wear such as Puddlesuits, coveralls and wellington boots. They must be clearly named!
