With Christmas just around the corner, Class 2 have worked incredibly hard this week!

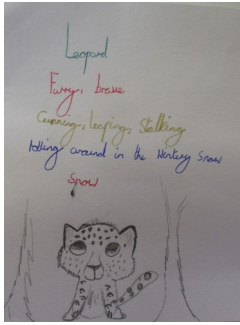

All the children are also very much looking forward to the Christmas Fair, all their jars look wonderful!

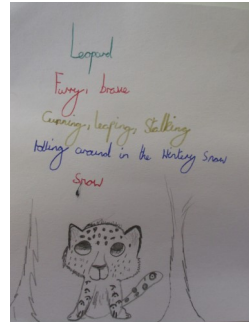

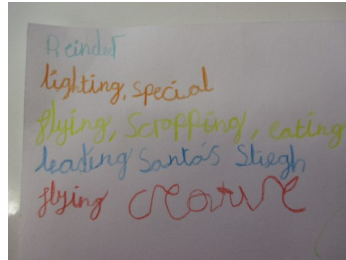
## Class 3 News
