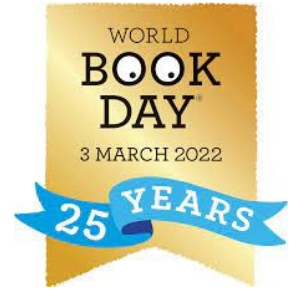

## Class 3

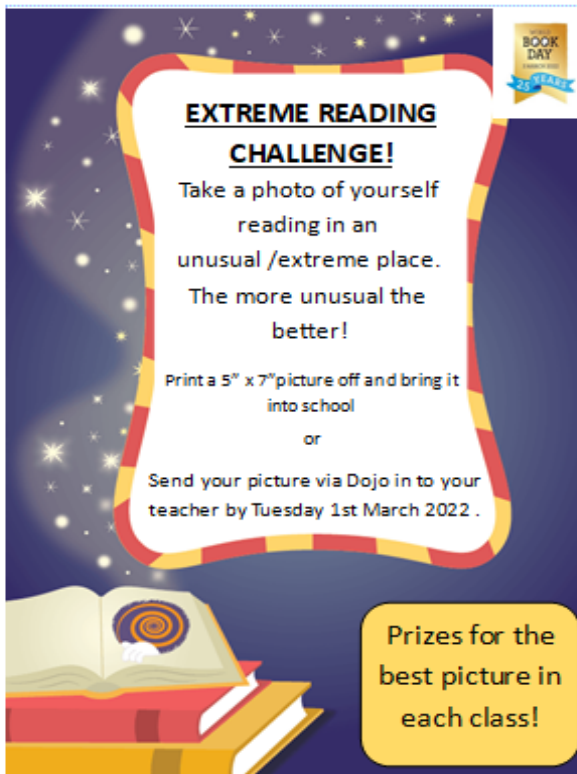

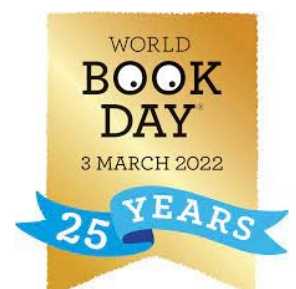
## Class 4 News
