School News:

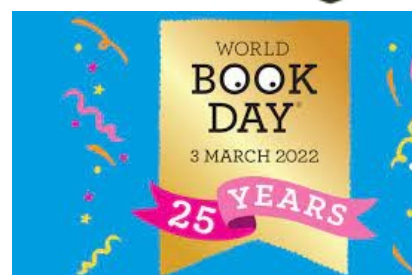
We hope you all have had a nice half term break and return to school refreshed.

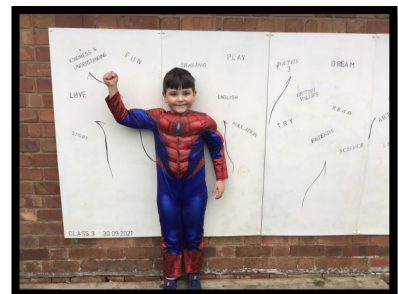
Class 2 news
