Class 3: The whole of Class 3 for their superb participation, politeness and enthusiasm during the Roman Day.

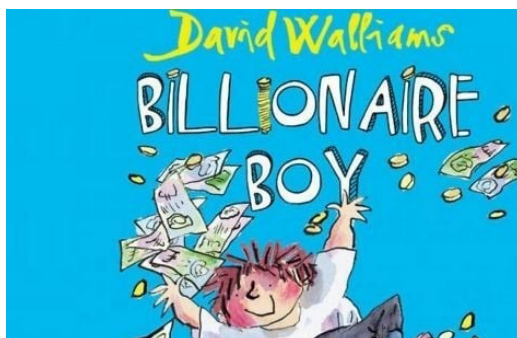
Class 4: Ada for politeness and Bella for determination.

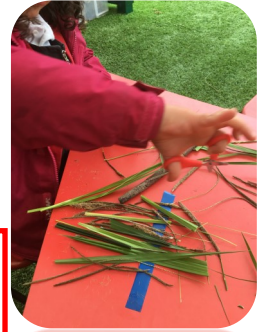
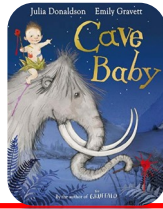
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Class 1 News
