Welcome Back—Welcome back to the start of another very busy year. Despite the very hot weather, the children have settled well in their new classes. I would just like to share a few updates of some of the changes that we have made for this year.

We launched our new curriculum this week. In our curriculum, we want children to have a deep understanding of their own story – to know where they have come from, what their own aspirations for the future are and what skills they will need to achieve them. By the time they leave Church Eaton, we want our children to understand that:

We will also be relaunching our Solution Circles next week. Children will continue to work in small groups to find solutions to problems. Amongst the challenges for this year are: developing a new wildlife area for the school, developing play leaders to lead lunchtime games and solve squabbles, creating an online prospectus to help new parents, teachers and pupils, producing vlogs on how we teach lessons at Church Eaton and running the Parent Open and Fundraising days.
