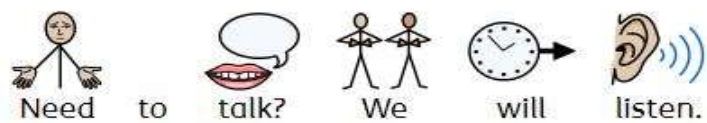
We know that sometimes adults or other children can hurt you. We want to make sure you know how to get help if you need to.
