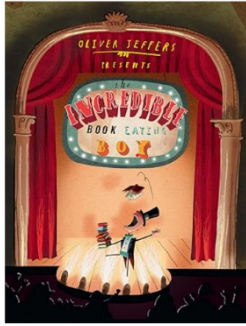

Changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics:

To perform an ostinato as part of a group.

Spelling:

Pupils learn how words are built using prefixes and suffixes, helping them spell and understand new words. They explore common patterns such as adding prefixes (e.g. un-, dis-, mis-) and suffixes (e.g. -ly, -ation), understand how these change meaning, and practise applying these rules to spell words correctly.

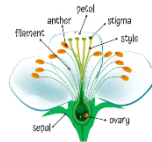

Plant Reproduction:

- Identify what plants need to grow healthily.
- Describe the structure and function of the parts of flowering plants.
- Investigate how plants transport water.
- Describe the life cycle of a flowering plant.
- Explain seed dispersal methods.



It's my time to shine:

"An Alien's Guide to Plants on Earth" 🐼 🌱

Pupils create a guide to help aliens understand plants on Earth. In their poster, comic, or presentation they explain what plants need to grow, label the parts of a flowering plant, describe the life cycle, explain how water moves through plants, and show different seed dispersal methods.

PSHE

Economic Wellbeing:

Pupils learn about money and financial choices, including different ways to pay for things and why some payment methods may be more suitable in certain situations. They explore what a budget is and how it helps people manage money, while also considering how spending choices can affect other people and the environment. Pupils also learn about the wide range of jobs available, how people's skills and interests influence their careers, and that job stereotypes exist but should not limit anyone's opportunities.

Cooking and Nutrition:

- Describe features of biscuits using taste, texture and appearance.
- Explain why some biscuits might be made for children, adults or special occasions.
- Remember and follow simple rules for working in a safe and clean way.
- Follow a recipe with support.
- Use a budget to plan a recipe.
- Adapt a recipe using additional ingredients to fit a design or budget.
- Measure and mix ingredients properly.
- Contribute to a discussion about criteria for evaluation.

- Identify water stores and processes in the water cycle.
- Describe the three courses of a river.
- Name the physical features of a river.
- Name some major rivers and their location.
- Describe different ways a river is used.
- List some of the problems around rivers.
- Describe human and physical features around a river.
- Identify the location of a river on an OS map.
- Make a judgement on the environmental quality in a river environment.
- Make suggestions on how a river environment could be improved.

River Rangers Report 

Pupils act as River Rangers, creating a poster, report, or presentation explaining river features, the water cycle, and how rivers are used.

Just how important are our beliefs?:

Considering how actions and practices demonstrate the importance of beliefs and whether we can tell what a person believes from the outside.

Pupils explore how people show commitment to their beliefs and communities. They learn about baby welcoming and commitment ceremonies, the promises adults make, and why these events are important in different religions and cultures. Pupils also investigate how people express beliefs through clothing, fasting, and dietary choices, and consider both visible and personal ways people show dedication to what they believe.
